## Achievements...

- 2011: World's largest test flight program by Lufthansa. 1100 flights conducted with a 50% HEFA-based blend provided by Neste Oil
- 2011: Foundation of aireg, the German alternative aviation fuels initiative. To date 32 stakeholders along the entire value chain form Europe's leading aviation biofuel initiative
- 2012: German-American Government agreement signed at AAFP during ILA 2012. Since then, CAAFI and aireg have executed a detailed work plan engaging on all levels of activity.
- 2013: German Government adopts the Mobility and Fuels Strategy calling for a "National Development Plan Alternative Aviation Fuels"
- 2013: CDU/CSU parliamentary group commits to support aireg and its aspirational goal of a 10% biojet blend in Germany by 2025.

## ...Next Steps

Top goals for 2025:

To achieve CO2-reduction targets set by policymakers and aviation industry:

- Domestic biorefining capacity with at least one industrial-scale facility
- Bilateral government agreements to safeguard provision of foreign feedstock
- Blending of 10% alternative aviation fuel in Germany
